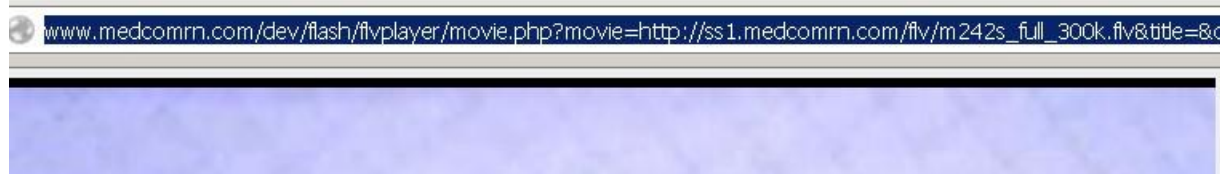


### Embedding Medcom videos in Blackboard-based classes

1. Open Chrome.
2. Go to Library tab in *My WATC*.
3. Find the *Online Videos* section in the center of the page.
4. Open *Medcom T3*.
5. Choose a video and click on the title- may need to wait a bit.
6. On the "Video Instructions (Video) page, choose "Flash."
7. Click on the address at the top of the screen and right-click to *Copy*.

9. Go to Blackboard and make sure it's on "edit."
10. Click on "course work."
11. Under the tab, "Build content," click on "web link."

12. Put the name of the video at the top, in the required field. *Paste* the URL address that had been copied earlier.
13. At top of page, click on "Submit"
14. If need be, click on "Activate."
15. Click on the video to see if it works.

### Embedding videos in PowerPoint:

1. Go to the Medcom videos (which changed to the clips overnight) and click on "persistent URL"
2. When the URL shows, right click and pick "Select all" and then pick "Copy."
3. Open your power point presentation and the slide where you want the video to open.
4. On the power point page, under the tab "Insert," there is a "media" section to the far right
5. Click on "Video" down arrow and choose ...
