If your household meets these criteria, you may qualify for discounted home internet service from Cox for just \$9.95 per month. For participating families, there are no deposits or annual contracts, and installation and in-home wifi is included at no additional charge.

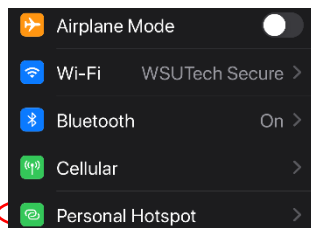
